He began his relationship with medicine at the University of the Basque Country's Faculty of Medicine and Dentistry, where he obtained his degree in Medicine and Surgery in 1998. As someone deeply involved in the practice of sport, he understands first-hand the significance of sports injuries and the suffering they entail. This led him to specialize in Orthopedic Surgery and Traumatology, as this exciting field is so closely related to sport. He became specialized at Santiago Hospital, Vitoria-Gasteiz, from 2001 to 2006.

In 2004, he began an outstanding professional career under Dr. Mikel Sánchez at the Arthroscopic Surgery Unit (UCA). At this unit, he received specialized training in arthroscopic surgery, minimally invasive treatments, as well as the application of biological therapies. In 2006, he received a grant from the Arthroscopic Surgery Unit to perform experimental surgery on-site and became an active member of the research team.
